- 4.3 Kaiser Permanente will not be liable for any damages, including, without limitation, any direct, indirect, special, incidental, punitive, or consequential damages for the malfunction, use or inability to use a charging station.
- 4.4 Vehicles must be moved after charging is complete. Violators will be ticketed/towed at vehicle owner's expense.
- 4.5 EV Charging Etiquette. Do not leave excess lengths of the charger cord out where people can trip on or drive over them. Neatly hang charging cord back onto holder for the next user.
